

Information for parents of students coming into Year 7 2026

Welcome to Centenary Heights State High School and thank you for your enrolment application for Year 7 2026. Please see below for further valuable information for you and your child for the upcoming year:

- 1. Student Resource Scheme Fees (SRS) for 2026 are \$362 what the SRS covers:
 - All textbooks, computer programs inc. Microsoft Office, Microsoft Defender, Adobe also including any other educational programs that your child may use here at school; consumables such as tissues, paper and printing are also included the SRS
 - What the SRS does not cover Laptop, Stationery, Camp Fees and/or any other additional fees such as extra-curricular activities, outside school sport etc
 - We ask that payment in full \$362 or first instalment fee of \$190 is paid prior to Orientation Day Tuesday 9 December or before student commences in 2026. We have payment plans available through the Textbook Office including Centrepay deductions.
- 2. Orientation Day for Year 7 2026 will take place on Tuesday 9 December from 8.45am to 2.55pm, this is a transition day for your child where they will be allocated their Pastoral Care Group (PCG), meet their teachers and fellow classmates. For your child to attend the Orientation Day we require payment in full \$362 or first instalment fee of \$190 to be paid towards the SRS by Friday 5 December 2025, please speak to our Textbook Office regarding payment plan options.
- **3. Stationery** we do not supply stationery packs however you will be issued with a Stationery list which can be provided to your preferred stationer
- **4.** Year 7 Camp 2026 Year 7 School Camp is \$345 (the Year 7 Camp fees are not included in the SRS) if you wish for your child to attend the School Camp, payment is to be made to the Textbook Office by 9.00am Monday 2 February 2026.
- **5. School Office opening hours**: Our office is open to parents and student from 8.15am 3.45pm Mon-Fri
- 6. Textbook Office opening hours: Monday Friday from 8.15am to 3.00pm
- 7. Uniform Shop opening hours:

Tuesday and Wednesday from 8.00am – 9.00am (more opening hours to be advised)
