**QUALIFICATION DESCRIPTION:**

The Certificate II in Sport Coaching program aims to reflect the role of individuals who apply the skills and knowledge to conduct pre-planned coaching sessions with foundation level participants in a specific sport. This qualification is a pathway to work in assistant coaching roles working or volunteering at community-based sports clubs and organisations in the Australian sport industry. Individuals with this qualification use a defined and limited range of basic coaching skills to engage participants in a specific sport and are involved in mainly routine and repetitive tasks using limited practical skills and basic sport industry knowledge. They work under the supervision of a coach.

**QUALIFICATION PACKAGING RULES:**

Students who successfully complete this qualification receive up to 4 QCE Points.

**ASSESSMENT:**

Assessment is competency based and therefore no levels of achievement are awarded. Assessments will be formative and conducted so that skills, knowledge and understanding may be demonstrated in the simulated workplace environment. Assessment of knowledge and skills will be integrated with assessment of their practical application. Projects/tasks and work evidence will be progressively gathered by the assessor for units of competency until sufficient valid evidence is gathered to make assessment decisions on competency. Evidence of skills and knowledge will be gathered simultaneously.

**CAREERS:**

Further study at TAFE and traineeships in various entry level coaching careers or employment in the sports industry.

**SERVICE AGREEMENT:**
