Assessment Block Conditions Term 4 2024

1. From Friday 15 November to Wednesday 20 November. Students only need to attend school for the days where they have an exam scheduled.
2. It is the student's responsibility to attend all exam sessions on the scheduled day and time for the subjects they are enrolled in.
3. Entry to the exam room is only at the session start time indicated on the exam timetable. This will ensure that students preparing/sitting for exams are not disturbed by students arriving late to the exam session. Students will be dismissed from the exam room at the direction of the supervisor.
4. Each student is required to place his/her ID card beside them on the desk. This will enable staff to mark attendance rolls without disturbing students.
5. All exam sessions are compulsory for students in the listed subjects. Absences from an exam due to illness will need to be covered by a medical certificate and we request this certificate be submitted to Ms Frew (Yr 11) and Mrs Priebe (Yr 10) for consideration. In the case of absence due to bereavement and/or family emergencies parents are requested to contact Ms Frew or Mrs Priebe prior to/or on the day. Families are to notify the school office of all other absences on the day of the exam.
6. Normal school rules apply during exam sessions:
 - i.e. full school uniform is required to be worn by all students attending exams.
 - i.e. shopping centre – Southtown is out of bounds during the day.
