*Please note that the Department of Education does not have personal accident insurance cover for students. Some incidental medical costs may be covered by Medicare. If you have private health insurance, some costs may also be covered by your provider. Any other costs must be covered by parents/carers. It is up to all parents/carers to decide what types and what level of private insurance they wish to arrange to cover their child. Please take this into consideration in deciding whether or not to allow your child to participate in this activity.*

- I hereby give permission for my child to attend the Bella Girl program and the excursion to the Thai Royal Restaurant on Tuesday in week 10 as per conditions of the letter attached and agree to delegate my authority to the teachers involved. Such teachers may take whatever disciplinary action they may deem necessary to ensure the safety, well-being and successful conduct of the students as a group, or individually, in the above-mentioned activity.
- I also authorise the teachers to obtain medical assistance which they deem necessary should an accident occur, and agree to pay all medical expenses incurred on behalf of the below student. With regard to an International student living in a homestay situation any medical costs will be covered by the student or natural parent.
