Your child has expressed an interest in completing a Work Experience placement within the Community Service sector (Childcare Centres, Aged Care Facilities, Health Facilities etc.). Before completing Work Experience in such fields, there may be a mandatory requirement to have a Blue Card.

There is no cost involved in obtaining a Blue Card, however it can take some time for an application to be processed following the submission of the relevant paperwork.

Students are able to collect the Blue Card Application form from their Case Manager at the Careers Office. Upon completion, the form is then submitted to the school's main office for approval. Two forms of identification are required to be submitted with the application form – one of which must contain the student's signature i.e. Bank Card, Learners Licence or an Australian Passport.
