Dear Parents/Carers

We wish to advise you of a change to the timing of Gold Level Ceremony for our current and future Year 11 students.

The current Year 11 students will receive acknowledgement during their Badge Ceremony on 7 February 2018 rather than with the Year 10s and 12s this term.

The rationale for this decision was based on consultation with younger students in the school who felt that the existing ceremony structure was too long, with three Year levels being acknowledged in each ceremony.

A subsequent consultation process was undertaken with both the Student Leadership Group and Senior Management Team, which identified the following:

- A desire to acknowledge students, with a more overt display of Gold Level achievement through presentation of a badge.
- A timing issue with holding Gold Level Ceremonies for Senior Students under the new School Assessment and Teritary Entrance System.

As a school we have determined the 2018 Year 11 cohort students will:

- Receive their Gold Level acknowledgement in Term 1 Year 12 in combination with the Senior Badge Ceremony
- For 2019 onwards, Gold Level Ceremonies will be held for
 - Year 7 and 8 – Term 4
 - Year 9 and 10 – Term 4
 - Year 12 – Term 1 of the following year
