**CONDITIONS/REQUIREMENTS OF YEAR 12 STUDENTS DURING THE ASSESSMENT PERIOD**  
**UNIT 3/TERM 1 2020**

1. It is the student's responsibility to attend exam sessions only when he/she has an exam scheduled. There will be a study room in the library for the entire block. Students are to sign in for each session on any given day.
2. Entry to the exam room is only at the session start time indicated on the exam timetable. This will ensure that students preparing/sitting for exams are not disturbed by students arriving late to the exam session. Departure from the exam room is only at the end of the session. (Please note: exceptions to this may occur with some oral/practical exams but only with notification from the subject teacher.)
3. Each student is required to place his/her ID card beside them on the desk. This will enable staff to mark attendance rolls without disturbing students.
4. All exam sessions are compulsory for students in the listed subjects. Absences from an exam due to illness will need to be covered by a doctor's certificate.
5. MOBILE PHONES ARE NOT TO BE TAKEN INTO EXAM ROOMS.
6. Normal school rules apply during exam sessions:
  - i.e. full school uniform is required to be worn by all students attending exams.
  - i.e. shopping centre – Southtown is out of bounds during the day.
  - i.e. student cars should not be parked in shopping centre bays.
