Just six months after I arrived in Toowoomba, COVID-19 struck. I haven't been able to see my family in China for three years. It was a very difficult time; however, the school's international team organized many fun activities for us to help alleviate our homesickness. When I mentioned to the international coordinator that I missed the Chinese street food, particularly the roasted stewed BBQ lamb, she brought in Chinese BBQ equipment and even organized a Chinese BBQ session for us. It tasted just like the BBQ back home.





The International team often communicated with my mom, which reassured my family about my well-being when I was far away from them. My mom frequently expressed her appreciation through emails.
